Structure of Programs - Some of the Things We Do!

Every group is guided by a Cameron House Youth Development Leader. Affectionately known as "Club Leaders", these volunteers lead the groups in fun and meaningful activities that promote positive and healthy relationships, leadership development, the value of service to the community, and exploration of spiritual growth. Our Youth Development Leaders are essential to the continued excellence of Friday Night Club.

• Harvest Home Service Project

During the Thanksgiving Season, the youth of Friday Night Club partner with Cameron House's Social Services Ministry. Together we raise money to buy food baskets for low-income families in our community. We collect donations door to door with our goal of \$4000 to put together 200 food baskets.

• Advent and Lenten Devotion

During the months of December and March respectively, we invite our youth introspectively slow down and take the time to reflect and nourish ourselves spiritually through song and the sharing of stories.

• Visual Performing Arts Festival

In February for the last 5 years, Friday Night Club has held its VPA festival for youth and alumni to showcase their talents and creativity in cinematography, singing, dancing, live skits, poetry, and other art forms. Check out our YouTube page!

• Youth Basketball & Volleyball

During the winter, we participate in the Asian Community Basketball Association (ACBA) and in the summer we partner with the Presbyterian Church in Chinatown to participate in the Chinese Christian Union

• Cameron Carnival

Every year since 1948 on the first Saturday of May, our annual tradition is to transform Cameron House's yard into Cameron Carnival. We do so with the help of the youth who spend March and April learning to design and put together concession games and prizes for our Carnival! There is also an annual play written and put on by our 12th grade youth group.

• CH Residence Camp at Westminster Woods

"West" is our annual youth residence camp—usually 2nd week of August. Campers spend a week (Sun-Fri) exploring nature, getting to know new friends, growing spiritually during our vespers devotional and laughing during campfire! Our camp is led by our Youth Development Leaders who plan and lead all activities. Registration for camp opens in May and is due by the 2nd week of July.
