While the past year was a continuation of the disruptive forces wreaking havoc on our public health, economy and social-political lives, we're also proud to say that our volunteers, staff and board continued to create value and critical services for our clients and participants, learned to deploy technology and effective partnerships to facilitate and scale our work; and clarified our strategic priorities and focus.

All of the last year, our team served to nourish and support people in their healing, learning, and thriving. Our teams counseled to ease depression and feelings of social isolation. We provided case management and supplemental gift cards to survivors of domestic violence and their children. We distributed food to homes and our weekly food pantry. We facilitated support groups by phone and webinars to promote mental wellness and used Zoom to help people stay connected with their loved ones and social networks.

We reinvented our fundraising calendar by necessity and seized the opportunity of engaging virtual events, direct appeals and sponsorships to substitute for an in-person gala and Cameron Carnival. And through private philanthropists, the Department of Children, Youth and Families, and Safer Together, our COVID-testing partner, we offered in-person camps for free this past summer and reinstated our Bilingual Afterschool Program. We're working to engage school teachers and parents/ families to create a social and learning environment that serves the needs of the whole learner.



For nearly 150 years, Cameron House has provided care and support for Chinese immigrant youth. Thousands of public school children grades 1 through 12, have grown up in our after school and summer programs.

Domestic Violence prevention and intervention programs support women and their children through case management, safety planning, emotional support, referrals to shelters and legal services, accompaniment to courts, and access to community resources.

\$44,750 in academic scholarships were awarded to 18 Friday Night Club high school seniors and Youth Development Leaders.




