A note from Liane Wong, Board President

In 2023, life finally started to feel “normal” after several years of the Covid pandemic. Your continued support for our invaluable work during this time allowed us to provide our services in-person, online and in the new hybrid mode.

A big focus was renewed emphasis on in-person events. Seeing old friends and feeling the warmth of our community never felt so good at Picnic in the Park, Joy on Joice, and Rekindle, Reconnect, Rediscover.

Our commitment to serve the San Francisco Chinese community shone brightly as a registered Heritage School. Martial arts, lion dancing, cooking and crafts are integrated into our youth curriculum to instill pride in Chinese culture and tradition. Our thriving Bilingual Afterschool Program (BAP) continued to operate at capacity with 60 children daily.

Unfortunately, our beloved Friday Night Club program was a casualty of the pandemic. Restarting and reimagining a program for high schoolers will be a priority.

Our Social Services department pivoted to serve counseling clients by offering hybrid sessions. Some clients returned in person, while others continued to meet via Zoom due to lingering fear of Covid and for convenience sake.

Serving immigrants through ESL classes had an enormous impact on our students' quality of life. Student Gina Zhou, a former teacher in China, said, “In the ten short weeks, I learned a lot of practical conversational English. My ESL teacher taught in Cantonese and English. My classmates and I wrote a thank you card to her at the end of the course. She commented, “Your bilingual ability is your wealth.” Indeed!” (translated from Chinese)

At the end of the year, we experienced a transition with the departure of Executive Director Michael Lee and the addition of Interim Executive Director Bhupendra Sheoran– a change in leadership is never easy. However, we are excited for what lies ahead: new leadership, new opportunities to serve the community, and last but not least, celebrating our 150th anniversary with you in 2024.

Cameron House is proud to present its 2023 annual report detailing our efforts to provide essential services and engage with our community members. Through dedication and hard work, we have strived to make a meaningful impact on the lives of those we serve.

Service Highlights

In 2023, our Social Services team dedicated themselves to providing crucial support to individuals and families in need. We delivered **466 hours** of individual and family counseling, along with over **1500 hours** of case management and support services. Our domestic violence prevention and intervention program assisted 46 clients with over 400 hours of service, offering comprehensive support including safety planning, emotional support, legal services, and access to shelters and community resources.

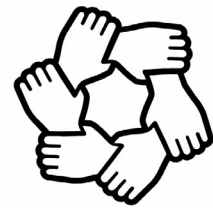


Our youth facing initiatives continue to serve and support young people through our afterschool programs and summer camps.

Our youth programs reached almost 200 youth providing 42,750 Hours of services

Summer Programs:

103 youths receiving 21,096 service hours



Bilingual Afterschool Program:

79 youths receiving 21,252 service hours

Friday Night Club:

15 youths receiving 402 service hours



We also had a Parent Support Group which served 6 parents for a total of 124.50 hours.



Additionally, our cancer support group program served 93 participants, providing **932 service hours**, with offerings in Cantonese and Mandarin to ensure accessibility. We also continued our commitment to adult education by delivering approximately 1,600 hours of basic computer and ESL classes in Cantonese, mainly to seniors.

Our food pantry program distributed approximately **4,500 lbs** of fresh fruits, vegetables, and protein to low-income families in Chinatown. **A total of 211,760 pounds was distributed last year!**



Community Engagement

Our efforts in marketing and communications saw significant growth and outreach in 2023. Through strategic online campaigns, we reached and engaged over **4,000 community members and stakeholders**, achieving over 26,000 impressions. Our targeted Facebook ads reached over 3,500 individuals, generating over 6,200 impressions. We are proud to report over 1,600 followers on Facebook and over 1,000 followers on Instagram, demonstrating a growing online presence. Additionally, our website experienced over 12,600 visits, indicating a strong interest in our services and programs.



Cameron House remains steadfast in its commitment to serving the community and providing vital resources and support to those in need. We are grateful for the dedication of our staff, volunteers, donors and supporters who have made our achievements possible. Planning for our 150th anniversary celebration in 2024 started in 2023. This sesquicentennial milestone recognizes our 150 years of serving the Chinese community in Chinatown and the larger San Francisco Bay Area, continuing our mission of empowerment and advocacy for all those we serve.

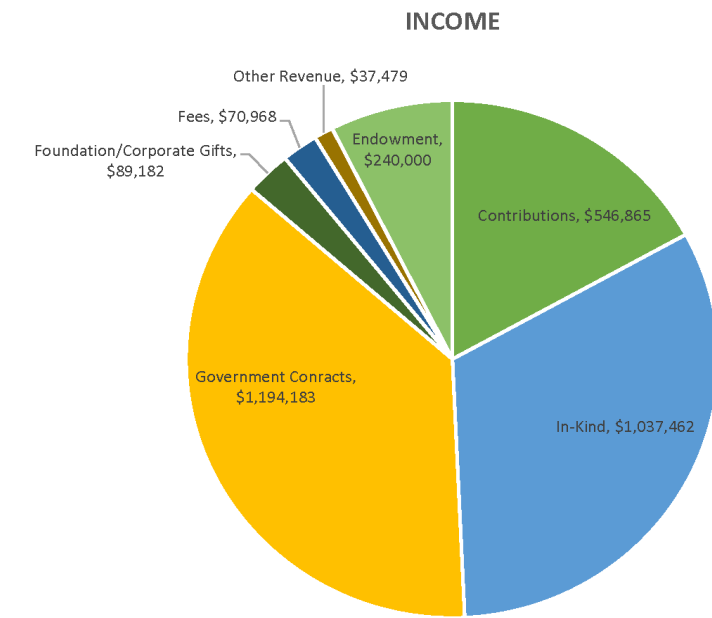

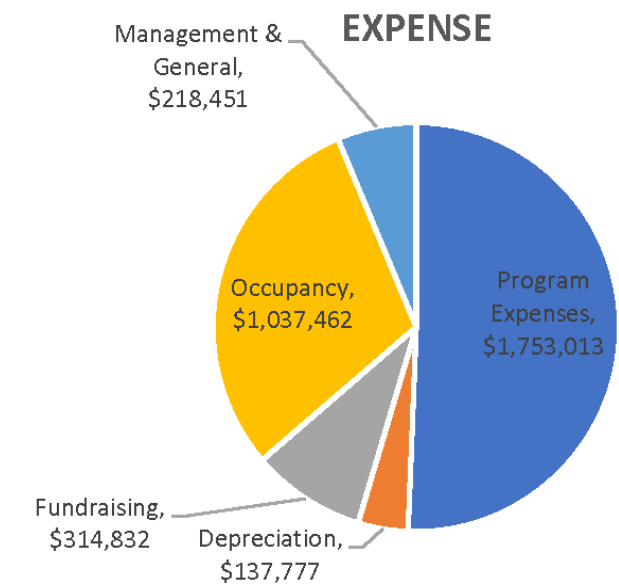
Financials: FY 2022-2023
